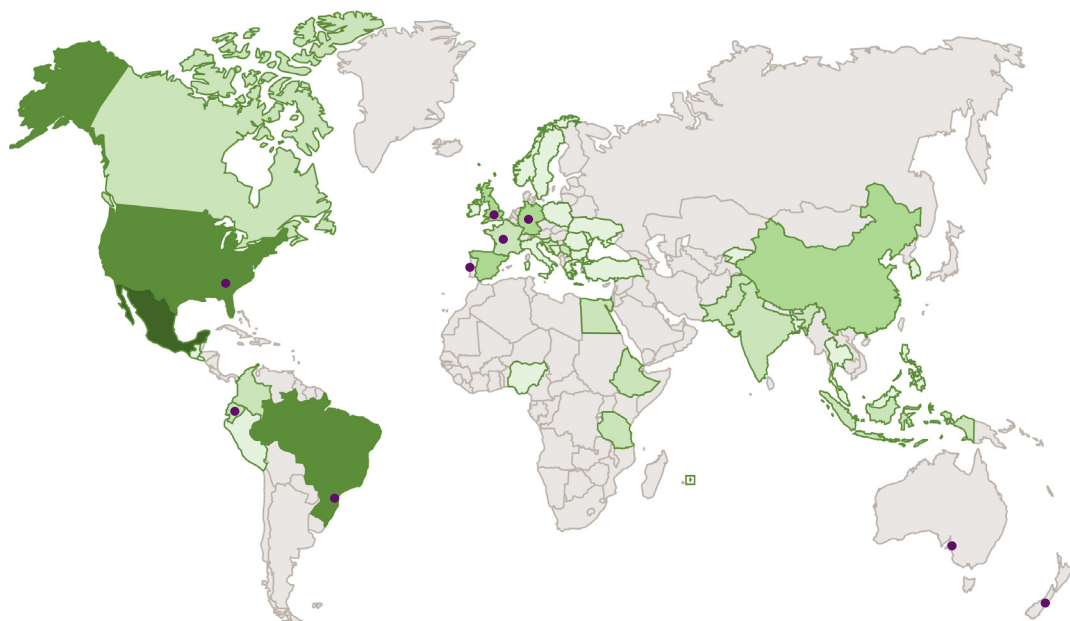

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TWO-YEARS TRAINING PERIOD IN APPLIED ECOLOGY

Gain a wide range of competences in ecology.
Become a specialist able to develop and lead ecological projects everywhere in the world.

WHO CAN APPLY ?

European and **non European** MSc students with a B.Sc. in the area of Biology, Ecology, Environment or equivalent, and with a fluent level in English.

COURSE PROGRAMM & MOBILITY

Yearly, a group of 20-24 students (Europeans and non Europeans) is selected. Welcome ceremony in France (Poitiers) at the end of August.

1st year (training period) with a mobility in 3 institutions (Europe and Ecuador):

- ▷ Language trainings
- ▷ Fundamental background in ecology and environmental sciences taught respectively in France (Poitiers).
- ▷ Field course on human impact on **Ecuadorian** tropical ecosystems (Amazonia, Andean highlands, Galapagos)
- ▷ Case studies either :
 - In **Portugal** (Coimbra) "Environmental Quality & Ecotoxicology"
 - Or in **Germany** (Kiel) "Functional approach of ecosystems"

2nd year (specialization period) in one of the 5 awarding institutions (Europe and Brazil):

France (Poitiers), England (Norwich), Germany (Kiel), Portugal (Coimbra), Brazil (Porto Alegre), according to the elected specialization:

- "Ecosystems management" or "Evolutionary ecology" (Université de Poitiers)
- "Environmental sciences and Conservation" (University of East Anglia)
- "Ecosystems functional analysis" (Christian-Albrechts Universität zu Kiel)
- "Environmental quality assessment" (Universidade de Coimbra)
- "Biodiversity assessment, conservation and management" (Universidade Federal do Rio Grande do Sul)

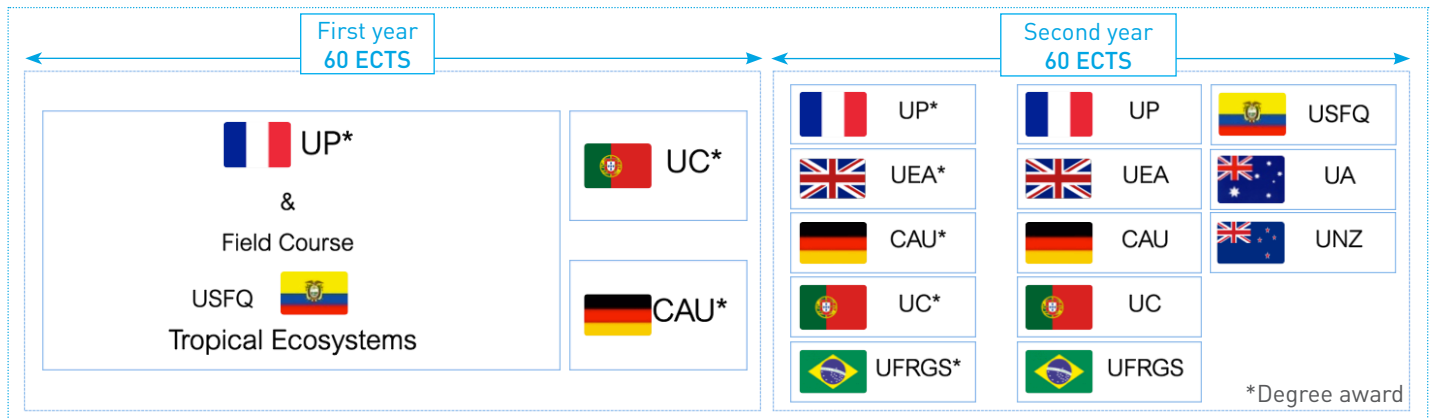
Take the opportunity to carry out part of your study program and/or Master thesis in our partner institutions in Europe, South America, Australia, New Zealand or anywhere else in the world.
